Dear Parents and Carers,

It has truly been a blessing to have the students all return to school this term. There has been lots of smiles, laughter and excitement around the school. Book Week

Next week will be celebrating Book Week and it will be loads of fun. We will be holding a 'socially distant' Book Week Parade on **Tuesday 20th October**. This year's theme is 'Curious Creatures, Wild Minds'. Students and staff are invited to dress up according to this theme or as their favourite book character for the day.

On Tuesday afternoon we will have a 'Big Read' where all students in the school will read books together on the oval and in other outdoor spaces. Students are asked to bring along one of their favourite picture story books to read with their buddy.
