### WEARIING OF FACE MASKS BY STUDENTS

For all school settings, the current guidelines from the Victorian Chief Health Officer:

- Directs primary school students in Year 3 and above to wear a face mask indoors at school, unless a lawful exception applies. Face masks can be removed while outdoors at school.
- Strongly recommends students in Prep to Grade 2 to wear a face mask indoors at school.
- A face mask must cover the nose and mouth.

Whilst the school has a small supply of disposable masks to assist when a student loses, breaks or forgets to bring their mask, it is the responsibility of parents to ensure that their child/ren bring their own mask to school.

To support students always having access to a mask, we suggest that families put an extra mask/s in the students' school bag.
