CHANGING OF SCHOOL UNIFORM

I'm pleased to announce that we will be undertaking a change to our current uniform commencing at the start of the 2023 school year. The new uniform has been designed to be more inclusive, more comfortable, better wearing and longer lasting. The change is being introduced to improve the current standard of uniform being worn by students in the school and to ensure that we have a cost effective, smart uniform that is a representative of the high standards we uphold.

The phasing out of the current uniform and the phasing in of the new uniform will occur over 2023 and 2024. The current uniforms can be worn until the end of the 2024 school year.

Consultation with uniform providers and specialists over many months has guided and informed the direction that the new uniform will take. We believe that the new garments will be positively received by parents, students, staff and the wider community. The new uniforms are available for viewing over the next two weeks. The uniforms will be on display in the front office area for viewing. We welcome feedback from families regarding the new garments. Feedback forms will be available in the front office should you like to make comment.

The new uniforms will be ready for purchase in November 2022 and able to be worn from the beginning of the 2023 school year. The new uniform will be stocked exclusively by Crocker's in Ballarat. We know that this will help to standardise the uniform and eliminate confusion with different shades and brand types. We hope that parents will appreciate the clarity over what is the correct uniform.

We hope the advance notice of this new uniform will enable you to plan your uniform purchases into the future. The school's second-hand uniform stall will continue to be open for the remainder of the year. Thank you, in advance, for your cooperation in this matter and for your support for the standards we wish to uphold for our school.
