
Next **Wednesday, 18th March**, we celebrate Ash Wednesday which marks the beginning of the Catholic Church's season of Lent, the six weeks of penitence before Easter. Parents are most welcome to attend our Whole School Prayer at 2.45pm, where the blessed Ashes will be distributed to all.

PROJECT COMPASSION

During the Lenten season, St. Thomas More Catholic Primary School will be supporting Caritas' Project Compassion initiative. This is Caritas Australia's annual fundraising and awareness raising appeal, bringing thousands of Australians in solidarity with the world's poor to help end poverty, promote justice and uphold dignity. It runs throughout the six weeks of Lent each year. Project Compassion is an extraordinary, ongoing demonstration of the faith, love and generosity of caring supporters, all in the name of justice and peace. The theme of Project Compassion for 2026 is "Unite Against Poverty"



Next week each family will receive a Project Compassion money collection box to be used to collect money during Lent. We ask that this money box and its contents be returned to school in the last week of the term so that all collected funds can be passed on to Caritas Australia to support their crucial work. To assist with our school fundraising effort for Project Compassion, we are hosting two fundraising events during Lent. On **Friday 27th February** the students are encouraged to wear "Crazy Socks" to school and on **Friday 13th March** the students will have a casual clothes day and participate in *Ks for Caritas* during the school day. On each of these days the students are encouraged to bring along a gold coin donation which will be passed on to Caritas Australia.

STAFF PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT – FLARE LITERACY STRATEGY

Next **Monday, 16th February** is a school closure day as our staff are undertaking their third day of professional learning with the FLARE Literacy Strategy. Our school has joined all Catholic Primary Schools across the Ballarat Diocese in looking into literacy practices and approaches that best support the growth of our students. The DOBCEL Flare Literacy Strategy has been implemented in Ballarat and is an approach to literacy instruction that applies a systematic, cumulative, explicit and diagnostic methodology to teaching phonology (the system of sounds within our language), sound-symbol relationships, syllables, morphology (the study of words and their parts), syntax (the arrangement of words within sentences) and semantics (the study of meaning in language) from Foundation to Year 6.



PARISH RECONCILIATION SACRAMENTAL PROGRAM

The Sacrament of Reconciliation Parent Information meetings will be held tomorrow: the first meeting will be held here at St Thomas More School, **Thursday 12th February at 9am** and repeated later in the day at St Patrick's Cathedral, in the Glowery/Mackillop Rooms at 5.30pm. Families who are eligible are asked to complete the attached forms, accompanied by a copy of their current Health Care Card and return them to the school office before the end of Term 1. CATHOLIC EDUCATION BALLARAT

A single enrolment application process is in place for all families seeking Foundation (Prep) enrolment for the 2027 school year at a Catholic primary school within the City of Ballarat (see school list contained in this document). This process includes families with children already enrolled in one of the eleven schools.

Note that information collected through the enrolment process is collated on a common database shared by the eleven schools.

Families seeking enrolment should follow the steps below to express their interest in enrolment by **Thursday 14 May 2026**.

Expression of Interest Process

1. Contact/visit the website of the school/s you are interested in enrolling your child at – see school list.
2. Engage with the school's process for conducting information sessions or school tours
3. Complete the online Expression of Interest form by 4.00pm on Thursday 14 May 2026 by visiting the [DOBCEL website](#) (click link). Note that this link will not be live until Monday 9 February 2026 at 9.00am.

Important:

- You will be asked to indicate your first, second and third preference schools.
- You will be required to upload your child's Birth Certificate and Baptism Certificate (if applicable).
- If you are unable to access the online form, contact Danielle at enrollments@dobcel.catholic.edu.au for assistance. Your query will be attended to as soon as possible.

- Once completed application forms are received, along with signed Parent Code of Conduct and Enrolment Agreement, a letter of offer will be sent to successful applicants.
- Each Catholic Primary School will make offers of enrolment in line with the [Diocese of Ballarat Enrolment Policy](#) which takes into consideration a variety of factors.

Concession Application: Family Fee Assistance Scheme

Parents/ Guardians who hold an eligible means-tested Centrelink Health Care Card, Pensioner Concession Card or Veteran Affairs Gold Card are eligible to apply for support under the Family Fee Assistance Scheme.

Eligible families are charged \$520 per annum (\$10 per week) for school tuition fees. The discount fee covers tuition and capital fees, but does not extend to charges for school camps, book hire or subject levies.
